

**Donate Yarn:** Recommended—Lion Brand Homespun, 3 skeins, same die lot.

**OR:** 555 yards for knit or 740 yards for crochet of machine washable/dryable yarn. We can use different colors and types if they are all machine washable

**Knit or Crochet a Prayer Shawl**— basic instructions below. Pray as you make the shawl for the recipient. Ask God to bring comfort, peace, healing—however God leads you to pray.

## -> Knitted Pattern

## Use 13-15 size needles

Cast on 63 stiches

K3, P3 to end (last three stitches will be knit.)

2nd row: K3P3

Make shawl 65 to 72 inches long. You may use fringe if you like.

Homespun yarn must be knotted if you use it for fringe.

## -> Crochet Pattern

Chain 60 stiches or desired width of shawl (20"?)(10.5 hook)

Chain 1, turn, single crochet in each of the stiches to the end.

Chain 3 and turn. Double crochet in top of each single crochet. Repeat this row 2 more times. Chain 1 and do 1 row single rochet to end. Chain 3 and turn. Do 3 rows of double crochet. Repeat pattern to end (1 row single, 3 rows double). End with 1 row single. Finish with fringe.

The above patterns are but a few of the ones available. Check www.LionBrand.com. They have a book The Prayer Shawl Ministry that has patterns. Check out www.shawlministry.com for other ideas. Besides knit and crochet; the shawls can be woven, sewn, quilted, or machine knitted. If you are unable to do any of the above, you can donate yarn or funds to buy yarn.
